Absorption Scheme

1. The students from the academic session shall be admitted to the credit based, letter grade pattern course. The students who were admitted to the LL.M. course during the 2011-12 session and also failure of the old batches shall continue to be governed by the old course and old pattern. However, such Students shall be required to complete their course within the three consecutive sessions i.e. 2012-13, 2013-14 & 2014-15. As such these students shall be getting 6 consecutive University examinations to complete their LL.M. Course.
2. The students of the old course who fail to complete their LL.M. course within the time permissible under para 1 above shall be absorbed in the new credit based, letter grade pattern course and they will be granted exemption in the equivalent papers. Their marks will be converted into appropriate letter Grade. Since presently no change in any specialization or the individual papers of the specialization are proposed and since only some paper numbers are changed and total marks of the paper on Legal Education and Research Methodology are reduced, there shall be appropriate reduction in the marks of this paper of the students absorbed under this scheme. Since the paper of computer and information Technology of the third Semester has been bifurcated into two paper one of theory and another of practical each carrying 100 marks a students absorbed under this scheme shall be given benefit of his earlier performance by proportional allocation of marks in these two papers.
3. The presents absorption scheme shall be valid till a new absorption scheme is proposed in future
